RULES

- Ages as at 1st January 2024.
- Each competitor to provide their own number bib and clearly print their competitor number.
- Start times will be issued for each rider in each class. These may alter on day depending on how fast classes run, we reserve the right to run early.
- This competition will be run under Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2023/2024. The judge's decision will be final. Please note that all whips must be padded.
- Classes will be SINGLE PHASE jumping, the second half will be timed. All competitors may jump the second half unless they have been eliminated.
- A combination may not compete in both class 1A or 1B and 1C
- No rider may ride more than one horse/pony in any one team. No horse/pony can be ridden in more than two classes.
- Horses/Ponies must be 5 years old and over.
- Any combination of horse and rider may not compete where the height is 30cm lower than that at which they have previously competed.
- Withdrawals after the entry closing date cannot be refunded.
- In the event of cancellation a notification will be posted on the TVHPC website and Facebook page. Monies will be refunded less £5 per entry administration fee.
- It is the responsibility of the Team Manager to familiarise the competitors with the correct turnout requirements as tack inspection is subject to COVID restrictions.
- Correct protective helmets must be tagged as per Pony Club 2024 rules.
- The wearing of body protectors is recommended.
- The warm up arena will be stewarded.
- The jumps in the warm up arena must not exceed the height of the jumps in the main ring.
- The organisers reserve the right to alter/cancel classes at their discretion, also to change start times. Please be prepared and allow enough time for classes to run early or late.
- Late changes/additions to entries will be accepted at the organiser's discretion.
- Liability: Neither the landowners, organisers, nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
- The organiser of the Event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all the Officials and Stewards.
- Dogs to preferably be left at home. Those that must be brought to the event must be kept on leads at all times.
